On 10-26-2017, members of the Clay County Sheriff's Office, Spencer Police Department, Iowa Division of Narcotics Enforcement, Osceola County Sheriff's Office, and the Iowa Great Lakes Drug Task Force executed a search warrant at the residence of Tracy Campbell, located at 206 35<sup>th</sup> Ave W in Spencer, Iowa. As a result of the search Tracy Campbell (age: 57), and Jaydee Carney (age: 31) were taken into custody and transported to the Clay County Jail. Campbell was found to be in possession of Methamphetamine, Marijuana, Psilocybin mushrooms, 3 prescription controlled substances, 7 additional prescription medications, and drug paraphernalia.

Campbell was charged with:

- Possession of methamphetamine (Serious Misdemeanor)
- Possession of marijuana 2<sup>nd</sup> offense (Serious Misdemeanor)
- Possession of Psilocybin (Serious Misdemeanor)
- (3) counts Possession of a controlled substance (Serious Misdemeanor)
- (7) Counts of Unlawful Possession of prescription drugs (Serious Misdemeanor)
- Possession of drug paraphernalia (Simple Misdemeanor)
- Failure to affix a drug tax stamp (Class D Felony)

Carney was found to have an active warrant for his arrest out of Cherokee County, and to be in possession of drug paraphernalia. Carney was charged with possession of drug paraphernalia (Simple Misdemeanor).
